

Nevermind Adventure supply the bikes and the tour with lunch included.





Indian Brisbane was one of the sponsors and displayed a line-up of the latest Indians – Bikes that is – although there was one wooden Indian maiden on one of the bikes. QHMCC member Ian Rennie also displayed some of his Vintage Indian bikes. They had the latest Ducati V4 race bike on the stage and running and also the famous MV Augusta 750 Four, what a sound.

Next year they have plans to exhibit the most expensive bike in the world, a Vincent that sold for over 1 million dollars. Plus, there will be another famous marquee to be featured – to be advised. 
Club Committee Meeting

Club General Meeting – are no longer held each month. There will be meetings called from time to time. This was passed at last year's meeting.






