Please give some serious consideration to nominating for a position on our Executive and Management committee.


It's a great club we have so let's keep it strong and believe me you will find it very rewarding to serve in one of these positions.






Club Committee Meeting

Club General Meeting – are no longer held each month. There will be meetings called from time to time. This was passed at last year's meeting.


