

This is the fourth year in a row I have caught up with my MotoGP enthusiastic friend at Philip Island, Fiona along with Tom and Martine.






In the pavilion there's bikes on show and gear you can check out.


Anyway folks, we all know we have to exercise that sixth sense and ride as safe as we can.


Club Committee Meeting

Deposit is required by the 22nd of November 2019 for catering.


