

Hi Members

Hasn't this year gone fast. We're in the second half of 2020.

By the time you're reading this, we will have had our first Biker's Brekky in about 4 months, this Saturday, 1st August. It'll be a departure from our usual Winter Sunshine show and ride that we've had in previous years.

The Gold Coast Show which has coincided with our show is now being held in December. And the Committee thought for a change, we would have our Biker's Brekky followed by a Poker Run.

And it was a shame we had to postpone our WAR (weekend away ride) for the third time due to the Covid19 crisis.

However, we keep riding our bikes and a few of us have new bikes or more modern second-hand ones now. We've even ventured into NSW again on our Saturday rides.

Now, as you know, the club subscribes to Australian Motorcycle Magazine easily the best mag you can buy.

There's a great write up of the 2020 Suzuki VStrom 1050XT, Kawasaki and KTM Lams 400cc models and Triumphs Daytona 765 Limited Edition bike.

Triumph have only made 765 plus an extra 765 for the USA and Canada market. It's a weapon but a bit pricey at \$27000 plus on road costs.

This bike is dripping in carbon fibre and quality components and is a road legal MOTO 2 replica. You can buy the Street RS Model for a few bucks less.

The mag is full of all the latest racing news and I loved the report on Round 8 2020 No show championship.



Briefly, Casey Stoner has been test riding for Royal Enfield developing the RE650PY 650cc 2 stroke race bike. While the electronics on four strokes are tightly controlled, no control ECU was nominated for 2 strokes so the RE team and Stoner developed a full electronics package that gave the bike great cornering speed and minimized the wear on soft tyres.

Casey went out on soft tyres and passed Marquez with two laps to go on to win the race.

Casey also recorded the fastest lap 1m 29.101 seconds. This was on a Royal Enfield 650cc 2 stroke. Marquez was second. Dovizioso was third and won the championship. Miller was fourth. It was quite a race and so good to see Casey back. Good ol Rossi was 16th. So, it's a good magazine. They are on the table at the club and we've got more room for social distancing now the pool table has been sold.





At the Queensland Art Gallery - 28 NOV 2020 – 26 APR 2021 GOMA | GALLERY 1.1 THE FAIRFAX GALLERY, GALLERY 1.2, GALLERY 1.3 ERIC & MARION TAYLOR GALLERY | TICKETED

This world-exclusive exhibition, only in Brisbane, will showcase the art, design and history of one of the most iconic objects of the last 150 years, the motorcycle.

Featuring more than 100 innovative and influential motorcycles from the 1860s to present day, it will consider the iconic vehicle from the perspective of social history, popular culture, design and technology.

The exhibition will tap into the appeal of this enduring object of design and art, looking at the motorcycle's past, present and future.

Highlights of the exhibition will include:

- A 1868 Michaux-Perraux, the first steam powered velocipede and oldest known motorcycle in the world;
- The earliest Australian-designed and built machines, including a Spencer produced in Brisbane in 1906;
- The 1951 Vincent Black Lightning that set an Australian land speed record in its day and more recently a world record for the highest price paid at auction for a motorcycle;
- Symbols of speed including the1930s Triumph Speed Twin, the 1970s Ducati 750 Super Sport, and the 1990s Britten V1000;
- Off-road motorcycles highlighting a rich history of bikes built for dust and dirt;
- Customised motorcycles at the intersection of art and design;
- Ultra-modern electric motorcycles, demonstrating the future of transportation in the age of renewable energy.

The exhibition will be accompanied by a range of special programs and events, including Up Late and a specially curated film program in GOMA's Australian Cinémathèque.

The MECGC will organise a Saturday ride to visit this amazing collection closer to the time – more details will follow.




